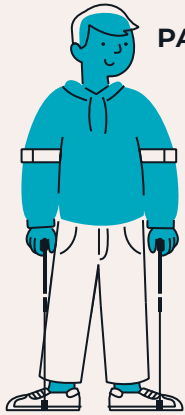
our campus: facilities and specialties

- **Children's Medical Center Dallas:** The full-service hospital has 488 licensed beds and is the **only Level I pediatric trauma center in North Texas**. The campus also has a Level IV neonatal intensive care unit, a pediatric intensive care unit, an on-site pediatric urgent care and a specialty center with a wide array of outpatient services
- **50+ specialties and subspecialties:** We are **nationally ranked in all 11 pediatric specialties** recognized by *U.S. News & World Report*, including Orthopedics, Gastroenterology and GI Surgery, Cardiology and Heart Surgery, Urology, Neurology and Neurosurgery, Diabetes and Endocrinology, Nephrology, Neonatology, Cancer, Pulmonology and Behavioral Health
