When to Call...

Call 911 immediately if your child:

- is not breathing or has severe difficulty breathing
- has skin or lips that look blue
- is having a seizure and you have not been taught how to manage
- you can not wake him or her up

Call the clinic or after hours number immediately if your child has:

- Fever of 101.5 or greater.
- Fever of 100.5 for more than 4 hours
- Bleeding that does not stop within 5-10 minutes
- A change in behavior or level of consciousness. (such as being very sleepy, or not making sense when talking)
- A sudden change in vision
- A severe headache
- New weakness of the face, arm, or leg
- Uncontrolled pain
- Repeated vomiting or diarrhea
- The inability to drink fluids
- A break in the central line, or unable to flush
- Drainage or puss from the port or central line site
- Exposure to chickenpox or shingles
- Anything that makes you worry
