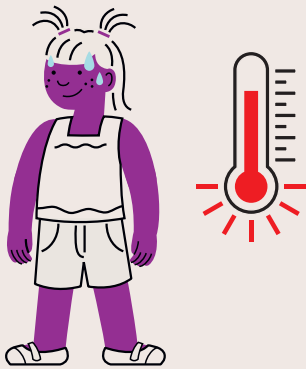
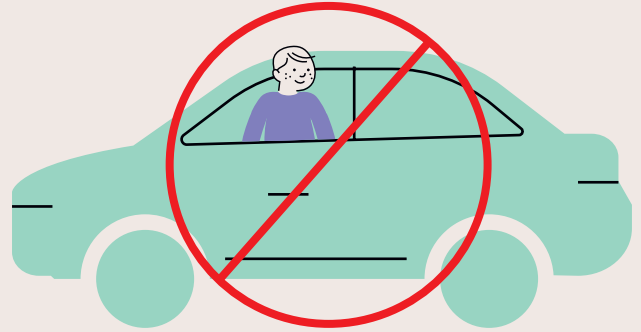


how to avoid the dangers of hot cars

Teach children cars are **not play areas**. Keep car doors locked and keys out of reach.

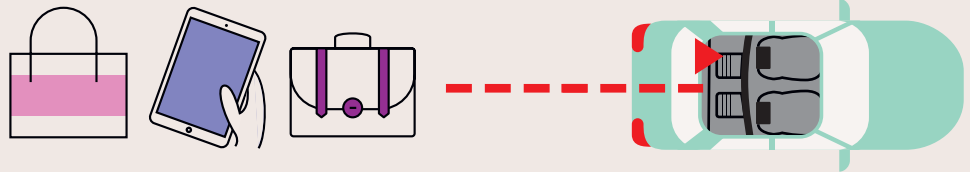
